

Location

Salisbury is located close to both the coast and countryside; the New Forest is just 30-minutes from the city and offers a protected forest with roaming ponies, deer and cattle; Dorset is an hour drive and provides access to Bournemouth and the stunning Jurassic Coast with 250 million years of the earth's history to discover.

Welcoming groups

Salisbury is a friendly city, welcoming visitors and your travel team. Coaches and minibuses can drop off close to the Cathedral and city centre in St John's Street or, the purpose-built 24-hour coach park at Millstream which has 23 spaces and is just a 5-minute walk into the city centre.

Climb the 332 steps where you'll be rewarded with sparkling views from the spire with a Twilight Tour of Salisbury Cathedral, experience Christmas time at the historic Mompesson House, get festive in the pop-up market, then time to enjoy some Christmas Shopping and our award-winning pantomime. Salisbury where tradition meets innovation this Christmas time.

Day 1

The first thing you'll see as you arrive is Salisbury Cathedral's spire, the tallest in the country. Standing at a breath-taking 404ft / 123m, it has been guiding travellers to Salisbury city for nearly 800 years. The Coach drop off point is in St John's Street, a short walk to Mompesson House in The Close.

Enjoy a sensory Christmas experience at Mompesson House, a quintessential eighteenth-century townhouse located in The Close. This beautiful historic home will be decorated for the season with upstairs and downstairs open, including a grand 12-foot Christmas tree. Finish off your trip with a cup of hot chocolate in the cosy tea-room.

For Small Groups looking for an adventure as well as some festive sparkle enjoy a Twilight Tower Tour at Salisbury Cathedral. Ten people can go up at a time and the views across the city at Christmas time reward the climb – 332 steps through the Cathedral's hidden roof spaces to the base of the Spire, then look out over the City of Stars and the Christmas lights, it's magical! Take some time to recover at the Cathedral's Refectory Restaurant, perfect for a spot of lunch.
